# Does programming resume when orange is obtained, or is green required before organized hockey returns?

• Our understanding is that if the zone returns to Orange and as long as Orange requirements are the same as Orange is as it was in November, then yes we would resume.

### What is the pricing structure for PPH skills?

• They will determine pricing as it will be offered independent of the LMHA.

### Will others skill providers will be offered to maximize participation?

• We can only assume as many as are interested and are able to get access to ice.

## Are skills going to be equally distributed per age groups?

• That will be up to the providers who run their own programs.

## Can refunded amounts be applied to skills rather than refunded?

• No – they are a separate business entity.

## Can LMHA skills also be run from the Libro in Amherstburg to offer more age groups?

• We are not offering skills sessions. We are however informing our membership when partner providers offer them. They are independent of the LMHA. It will be up to the 3rd party providers to determine if, where and when they might be offering skills sessions.

# Can skills secessions be used as end of season evaluations for players from coaches?

• At this time and according the OHF and OMHA, we are not permitted to hold any type of evaluations or tryouts.

### What is the refund amount for the 45min ice time divisions? Is it larger?

• Depends on the hours used by each division. Contact the registration director for specifics.

#### Will the Vollmer remain open?

• It is presently closed as are most recreational complexes in the area. When the Vollmer will re-open is not determined.

# What is the travel outlook since Amherstburg has withdrawn and Belle River has made alternate plans?

• Our travel director is working on this. We unfortunately do not know at this time.

# Will LMHA travel create an in-house minor/major age group league to potentially continue games?

• To be determined by our staff. A lot depends on the previous question.
